SHADOWING OPPORUNITIES

UNC Health Nash offers shadowing opportunities to non-employees, such as students and visitors, who want to learn more about healthcare careers. Participants observe a staff mentor in the workplace, ask questions, and meet with department leaders to better understand the field.

This is an observation-only experience—no direct patient care is allowed.

To participate in a shadowing opportunity at UNC Health Nash:

- · Students and visitors must be at least 16 years of age
- Students must be enrolled in high school or an accredited college.
- Have a hospital employee or department sponsor them.
- Sign an agreement outlining their responsibilities before shadowing begins.
- Follow all UNC Health Nash policies during their time in the program.
- Provide required immunization records and submit a Confidentiality Form.

High school students can shadow up to 8 hours, while college students and visitors may shadow up to 40 hours.
