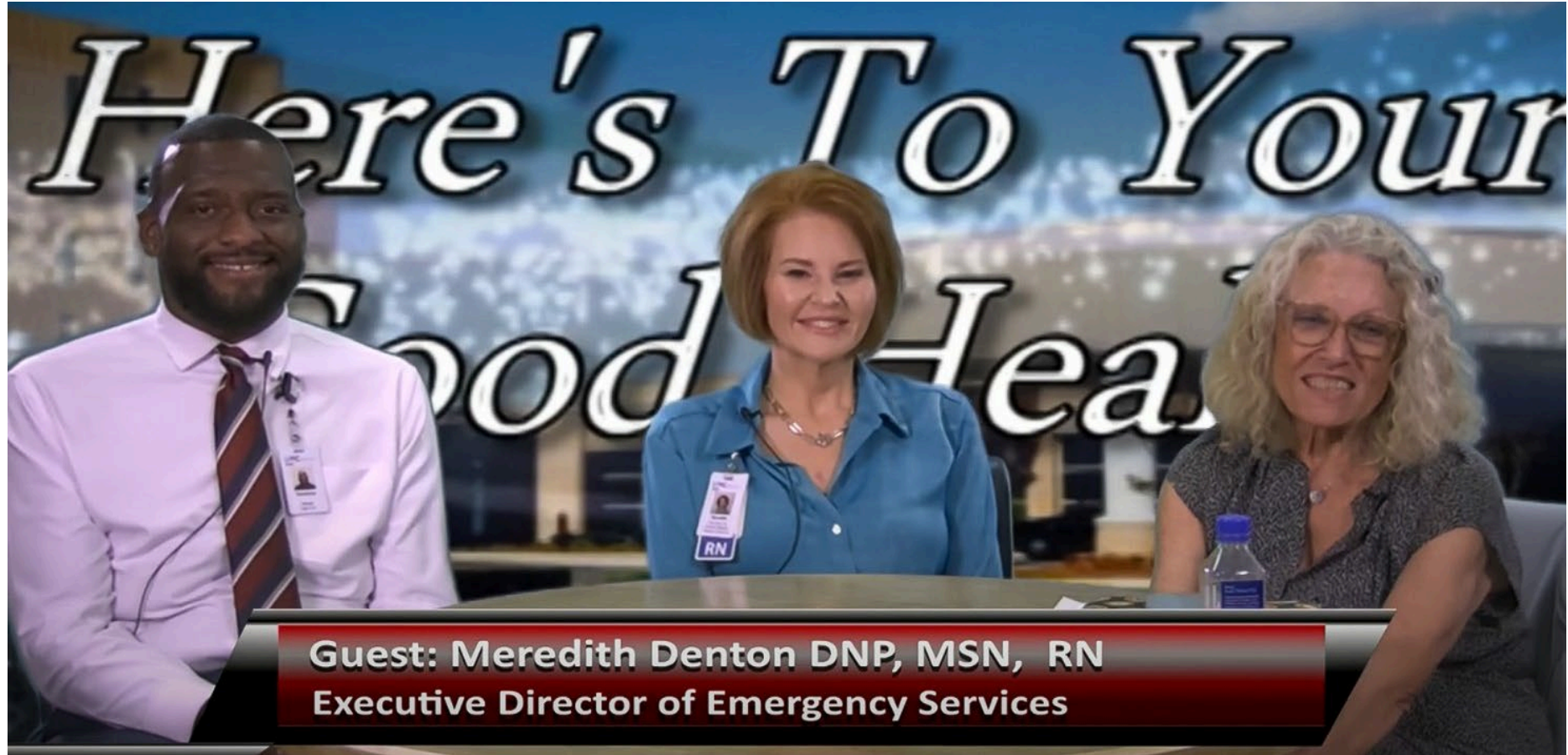
Hospital Week 2025 was a smashing success!

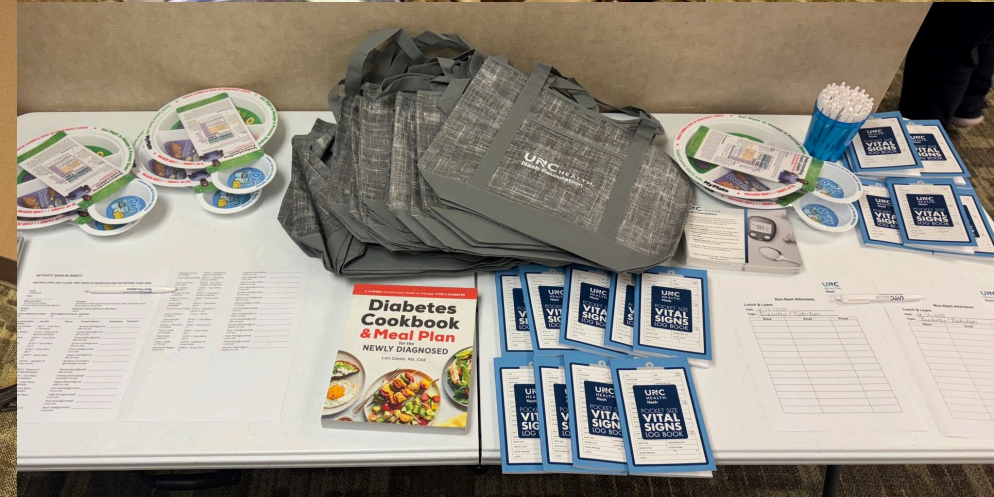

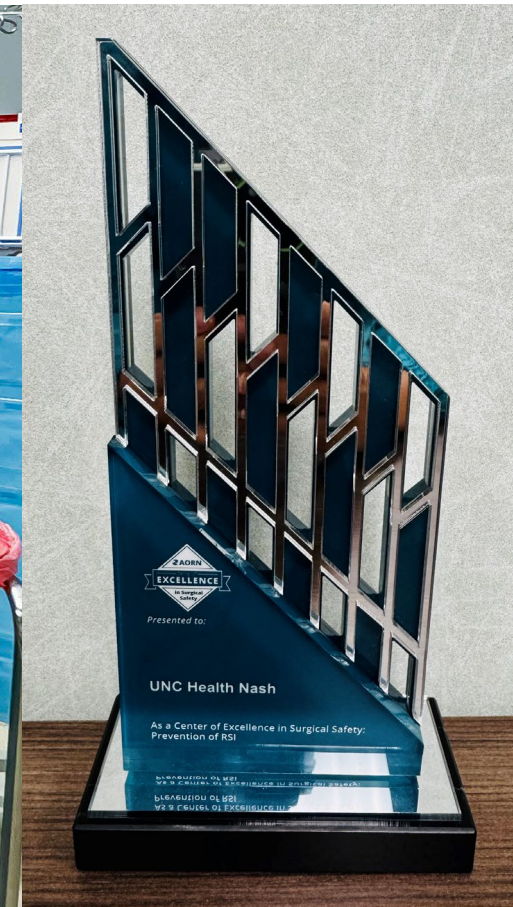
UNC Health Nash team members came together to support young athletes across our community through our annual Free Sports Physicals Clinic.

The Nash Women's Center welcomed Nash County's first baby of—a baby boy named Karter—born to parents MaKaelah Joyner and Alonte Givens.



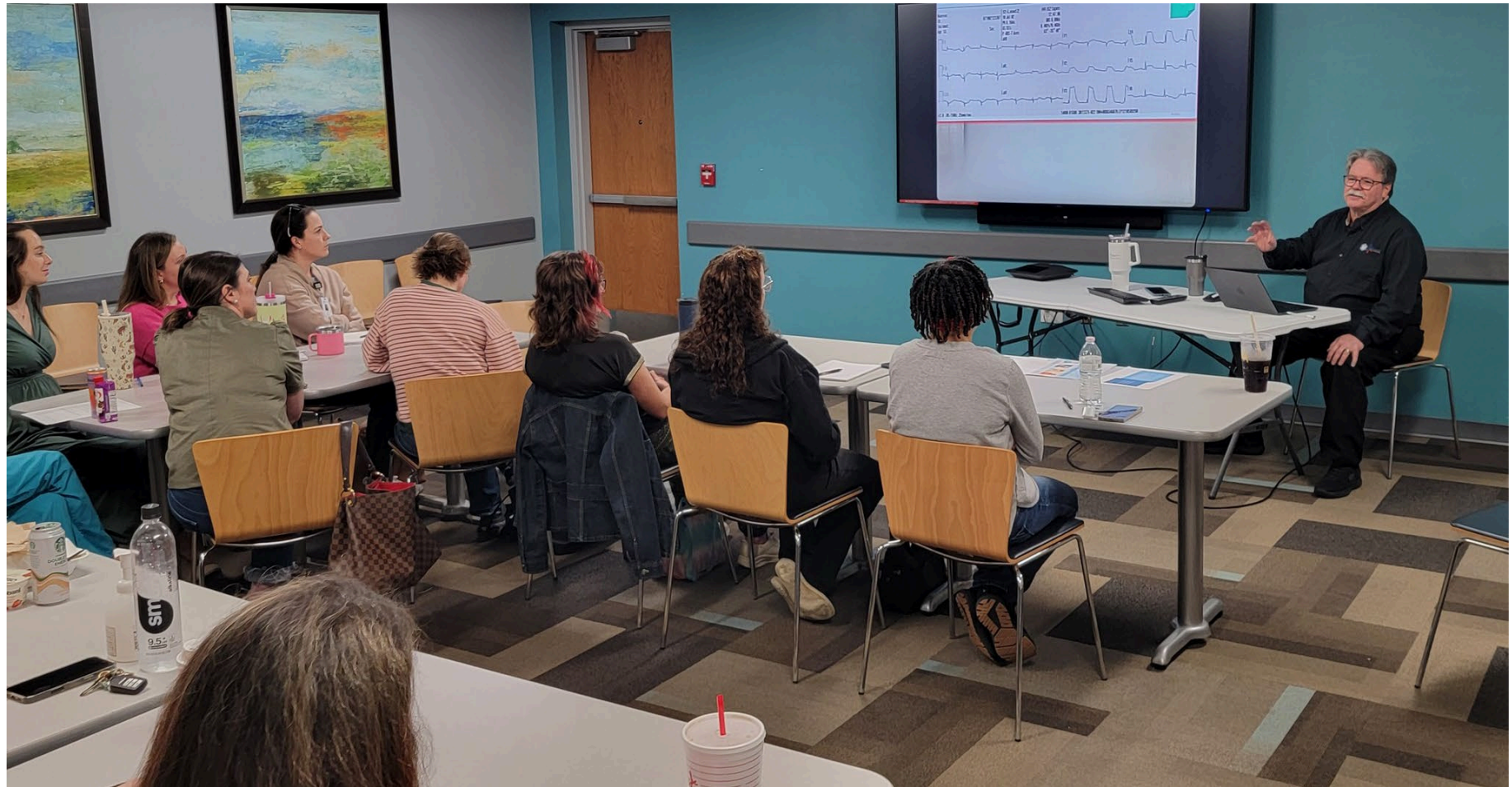
Kenneth D. Arrington was appointed as chairman of the UNC Health Nash Board of Commissioners.

Flu season arrived early and hit hard; Dr. Connie Smith shared valuable prevention guidance with our community on WHIG-TV's *Live Morning Show*.



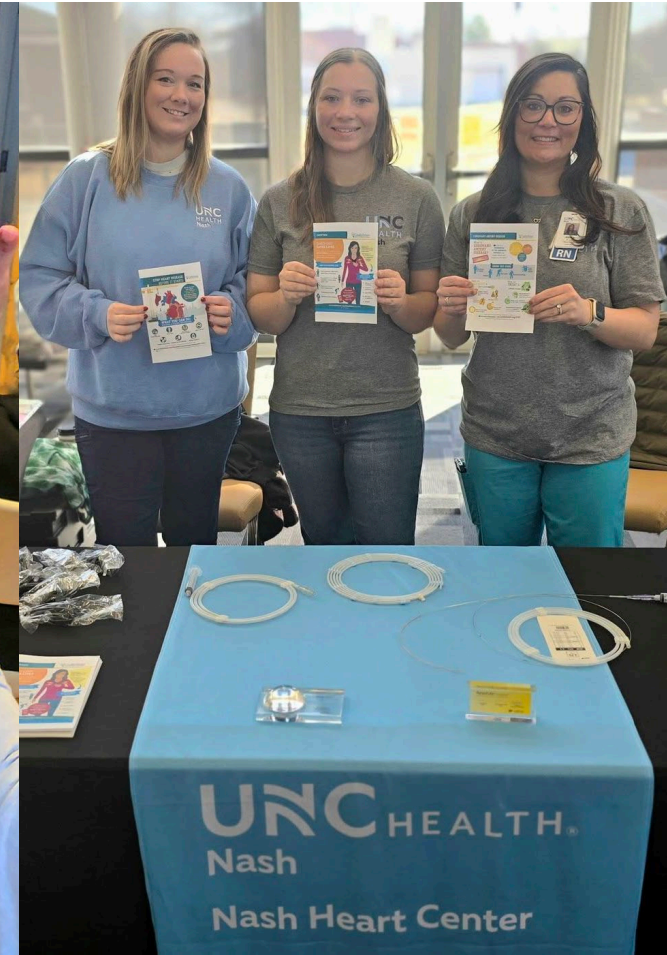

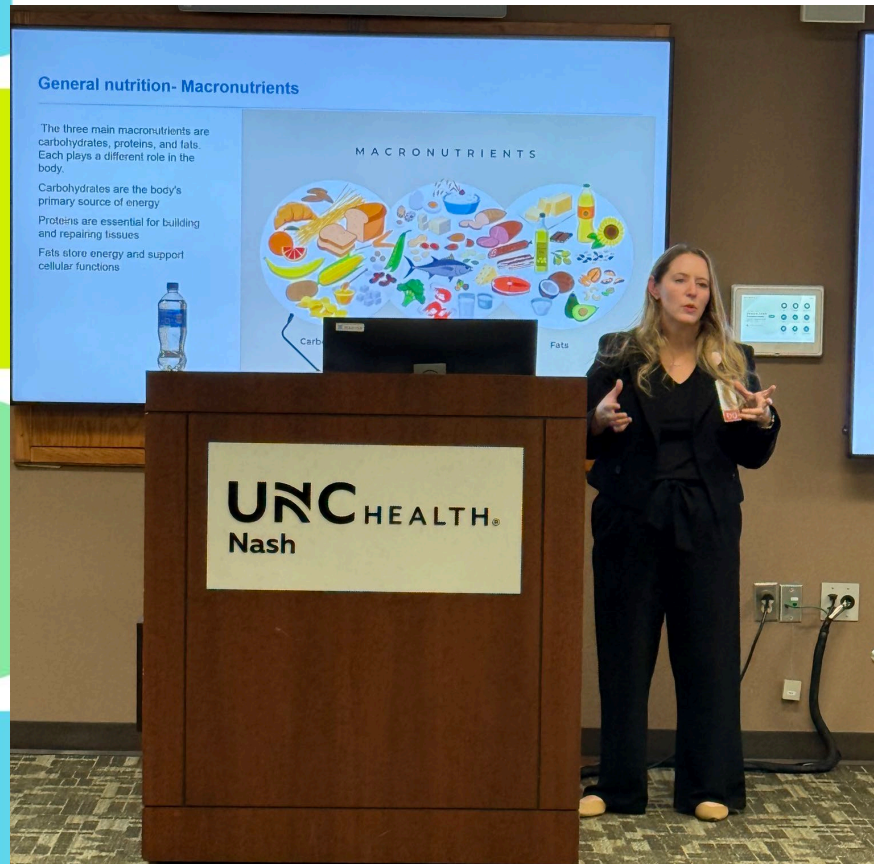
